CORPORATE CHARTER

KNOW ALL YE BY THESE PRESENTS that a Corporate Charter is bestowed this day, January 10, 2010, upon the NATIVE AMERICAN LAW & JUSTICE CENTER (NALJC) helmed by Justice Silver Cloud Musafir (Navin-Chandra Naidu, born 9th January 1948, in Singapore) and His Honor's Law Team comprising judges, lawyers, paralegals and support staff from a global pool of talent.

NALJC's duties, functions, obligations and responsibilities shall include, and not be limited to, offering economic and political advice concerning private Tribal banking protocols; entering into Treaty relationships with other nation-states; operating a Ministry of Law & Justice for the Xi Anu Nation; a law college; a law clinic for assisting tribal members in criminal and civil matters; maintaining the Rules of the Tribal Court; issuing Judgments and other Orders necessary for the safety, security, and welfare of Aboriginal Tribes, Clans, Bands and Nations in continental America and Canada (Turtle Island), and other parts of the world where Aboriginal Peoples need legal, economic and political assistance under the rule of law based on natural law and justice.

As a Treaty Tribe recognized under international law, and Article VI, section 2 of the Constitution of the United States of America, this Tribal government further bestows the academic equivalent of *Doctor of Laws* upon Justice Naidu for his relentless work in Aboriginal affairs since 1989 in Turtle Island and elsewhere advancing the cause of Aboriginal Peoples through law lectures and seminars, scholarly articles, and pragmatic decisions as a presiding judge.
